ADDENDUM TO RESUME OF SERVICE CAREER

JAMES EDWARD HARDIN, JR., Colonel, Judge Advocate (Army Reserve)

CURRENT OCCUPATION: Resident Superior Court Judge, General Court of Justice, State of North Carolina

As a Resident Superior Court Judge I preside over felony offenses and civil lawsuits where more than \$10,000 is being sought in damages in the Superior Courts, General Court of Justice, across the State of North Carolina. Since my investiture to the Superior Court in April of 2005, I have held court in fifty-eight (58) of the one hundred (100) counties of North Carolina.

On 20 June 2007, the Governor of North Carolina requested that I temporarily assume the position and duties as the Interim District Attorney for the Fourteenth Prosecutorial District of North Carolina to replace the recently disbarred Elected District Attorney of this jurisdiction. I was selected to fill this interim position due to the unique experience that I had as the Elected District Attorney for this jurisdiction from January 1994 to April 2005. I was re-appointed to my position as a Special Superior Court Judge by the Governor of North Carolina on 07 September 07 and was appointed as a Resident Superior Court Judge by our Governor on 22 September 2009.
